



Wimbledon Park Lake Project - (Reservoir Safety and Desilting)

Summary of Technical Steering Group Meeting – 04 December 2018

Programme of Activities

- Noted that the 6th November 2018 meeting had been cancelled due to availability of members of the group on that date
- Eel Survey – report previously agreed by the group approved for publication
- Geo-technical survey – the draft brief for this work includes a condition survey of the existing sheet piling, surveying the dam with 5 boreholes, condition survey of the culverts/headwall from the lake. It was agreed that the depth of these boreholes should be sufficiently deep enough to reveal archaeological heritage and matters of historic interest, with input/onsite overview from Museum of London Archaeology.
- Discussions with Thames Water are taking place giving consideration to the potential undertaking of a condition/CCTV survey to assess the condition of the surface water sewer (which is a Thames Water asset) from where it leaves the park to the Wandle.
- The Stage Two Flood Risk Report is not yet finalised and this will be in final draft format in February when the group had been able to review the early draft proposals at January's scoping meeting.
- The January meeting will be set aside solely to look at the draft options from the Stage Two report as part of the Project Scoping being undertaken.
