



Wimbledon Park Lake Project - (Reservoir Safety and Desilting)

Summary of Technical Steering Group Meeting – 30 April 2019

Surveys:

- It was noted that when the Geotechnical Survey is undertaken there will need to be closures to areas in which the investigations are taking place and public notices will need to be displayed in advance.
- The Environment Agency are to be asked whether there will be a need to update any of the earlier surveys completed for compliance with any future planning applications – a pre-app has been submitted to check this out.

Procurements:

- An overview of different procurement options was provided.
- Main contract for the works was agreed should be a Design and Build contract.
- Environment Agency, AELTC and LBM officers will evaluate tenders for the main contract.
- A report now needs to be taken through the council's procurement processes for procurement to commence.

Flood Study Report – Stage 2:

- A second full draft report has now been received for further review and comments.
- It was noted that the scope of this report is regarding Reservoir Safety.
- Discussion took place regarding the potential lowering of the water level within the lake.
- BWB to be invited to the next meeting to present the draft report and receive comments.

Water Quality and Pollution:

- It was noted there were some issues with reeds by the current outfall which AELTC will investigate.

Heritage, History and Archaeology:

- Heritage England to provide some narrative for the main design and build contract.

Timeline:

- The draft timeline will be amended to include a planning application process.

Risk Assessment:

- This was reviewed and updated
