

Dear Resident / Business,

The purpose of this newsletter is to inform you that Merton Council will be implementing footway and carriageway improvements on The Path just off its Junction with Morden Road.

These improvements will create better use of this open space making it more attractive and a safer route for pedestrians and cyclists.

The proposed improvements include the following as shown on the plan overleaf.

- Build out of the junction to provide a shorter and safer crossing point for pedestrians.
- Rain garden watered by diverting surface water from the adjacent carriageway.
- Footway re-profiling and surfacing.
- Resurface of carriageway at the junction with Morden Road.
- New Mediterranean plants and two mature trees to be planted in the tree planting season between November and March (tree species to be confirmed).

What happens next

The implementation of the proposed improvements are due to commence 10th May 2021 and are expected to take 6 weeks to complete. We would like to apologise in advance for any disruption that these works may cause.
