#### **Dear Resident / Business**

This leaflet is to update you of the outcome of the second informal consultation that was carried out between 25 April and 24 May 2019 to determine if the residents of Hallowell Close would like to be included in MTC2 Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) which includes Commonside East area, operational Monday to Saturday between 8.30am and 6.30pm. the second informal consultation was carried out due to a number of complaints received during the implementation of the zone.

The second informal consultation resulted in 15 households respondig representing a response rate of 40.5%. Of the 15 who responded, 80% want the CPZ removed, compared to 20% who support the CPZ. All comments received during the consultation along with officer's recommendations were reported to the Cabinet Member for Member for Regeneration, Housing and Transport in June 2019. After careful consideration it has been agreed to:

- removal of Hallowell Close from the recently introduced MTC2 CPZ as shown in Drawing No. Z78-354-03.
- retain the recently introduced 'At any time' waiting restrictions and the banned footway parking in Hallowell Close as shown in Drawing No. Z78-354-03.

#### What happens next

The final made TMO, which allows the restrictions to be implemented and administered and the removal of Hallowell Close from the TMO, will be published in the London Gazette and the local newspaper shortly. Notices will also be placed on lamp columns in the affected areas. It is anticipated

that the CPZ will come into operation on 1 July 2019
