

**LONDON BOROUGH OF MERTON
(WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO. *) ORDER 201-
Ashcombe Road and Gap Road**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Merton under the powers conferred by Sections 6 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, propose to make the above mentioned Order.
2. The general effects of this Order will be to introduce at any time waiting restrictions (double yellow lines) and a loading restriction in the lengths of the roads detailed in the Schedule to this Notice.
3. A copy of the draft Order, a plan identifying the area affected by the draft Order and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Order can be inspected during the Council's normal office hours Mondays to Fridays at Merton Link, Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden, Surrey.
4. Any person desiring to object to the proposed Order should send a statement in writing of their objections and the grounds thereof to the Environment and Regeneration Department (Ref ES/SGE/GAP-ASHCOMBE ROAD) at the Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden, Surrey, SM4 5DX no later than 9th December 2011.

SCHEDULE

Waiting Restrictions operating at any time, upgrade existing single yellow line

Gap Road

North Side

From a point 3.4 metres east of the eastern flank wall of property number 70 Gap Road in an eastwards for a distance of 26 metres.

Loading Restrictions Operating 'At any time'

Ashcombe Road

Western and Eastern kerblines

From the southern kerblines of Gap Road to a point 7.4 metres south of that point.

Gap Road

Northern kerblines

From a point 3.4 metres east of the eastern flank wall of property number 70 Gap Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 26 metres.

Southern kerblines

From a point 9.8 metres west of the western kerblines of Ashcombe Road to a point 6.6 metres east of the eastern kerblines of Ashcombe Road.
