NOTICE UNDER SECTION 90A OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Merton under the powers conferred by sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, propose to make the above mentioned Orders.
2. The general effect of the "Parking Places" Order would be to relocate 6 parking spaces situated in Southey Road, the west side, outside Pelham Primary School to the locations specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice.
3. The general effect of the "Waiting and Loading" Orders would be to:-
  - (a) introduce "at any time" loading restrictions in Southey Road:-
    - (i) the east side, from the northern kerb-line of Kingston Road northward for 10 metres;
    - (ii) the west side, from the northern kerb-line of Kingston Road northward for 14 metres;
  - (b) further amend the Merton (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1977 so that waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited at any time in the lengths of Southey Road specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice (generally at locations of crossovers in Southey Road, the east side).
4. The general effect of the 'Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools' Order would be to relocate and shorten the school entrance markings outside Pelham Primary School in the Southey Road, the west side, so that they extend from a point 1.5 metres north of a point opposite the common boundary of Nos. 24 and 26 Southey Road to a point 11 metres north of the northern boundary Bickley Court, Southey Road, so as to prohibit any vehicle stopping or remaining at rest between 8.00am to 5.00pm Mondays to Fridays inclusive.
5. The prohibition in paragraph 4 above would not apply to:-
  - (a) any person causing or permitting a vehicle to stop or remain at rest:-
    - (i) if that person is obliged to do so in order to prevent an accident; or
    - (ii) if that person is required to do by law;
  - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway by or on behalf of the Metropolitan Police.

6. The Council also propose to install raised tables extending the full width of the road with a maximum height of 75 millimetres above road level and an on-off ramp gradient no steeper than 1:20 under section 90 A-F of the Highways Act 1980 at the locations specified in Schedule 3 to this Notice. This would require the removal of the set of 3 speed cushions in Southey Road, outside Dolphin Court and outside the fire station. Locations in Schedule 4 to this Notice show the locations of the sets of speed cushions that would remain in Southey Road.
7. A copy of the proposed Orders and other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders, including a plan which indicates the lengths of road to which the Orders relate can be inspected Monday to Friday during normal office hours at Merton Link, Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden, Surrey until 6 weeks have elapsed from the date on which either the Orders are made or the Council decides not to make the Orders.
8. ## SCHEDULE 1

### (Shared-Use Parking Places)

Southey Road  
the west side,

- (a) from a point 6 metres north of a point opposite the southern boundary of No. 6 Southey Road, northward for a distance of 10.5 metres;
- (b) from a point 6.5 metres south of a point opposite the southern boundary of No. 6 Southey Road, southward for a distance of 10.5 metres;
- (c) from a point 24 metres south of a point opposite the southern boundary of No. 6 Southey Road, southward for a distance of 10.5 metres.

## **SCHEDULE 2**

### **("At Any Time" Waiting Restrictions)**

Southey Road  
the east side,

- (a) from a point 38 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Kingston Road to a point opposite the southern boundary of No. 30 Southey Road;
- (b) from a point 4 metres north of a point opposite the southern boundary of No. 28 Southey Road northward to a point 5 metres south of the party wall of Nos. 24 and 26 Southey Road;
- (c) from the party wall of Nos. 24 and 26 Southey Road northward for a distance of 8 metres;
- (d) from a point 6 metres south of the common boundary of Bridge Court, Southey Road and No. 22 Southey Road, northward for a distance of 7.5 metres;
- (e) from a point 4.5 metres south of the common boundary of Bickley Court and Bridge Court, Southey Road, northward for a distance of 5 metres;
- (f) from a point 8 metres south of the northern boundary of Bickley Court, Southey Road northward for a distance of 9 metres.

## **SCHEDULE 3**

### **(Proposed Raised Tables)**

Raised entry table from the northern kerb-line of Kingston Road northward for a distance of 7.8 metres;

Raised table from the common boundary of Nos. 24 and 26 Southey Road northward for a distance of 60.7 metres.

### **(Locations Of Existing Speed Cushions (Sets Of 3) To Remain In Southey Road)**

Outside Highlands House, Southey Road

Outside Nos. 9/11 Southey Road

In Southey Road, adjacent to the flank wall of No. 50 Griffiths Road

In Southey Road, adjacent to the flank wall of No. 69 Pelham Road

Outside Nos. 7 to 12 Martin Court, Southey Road
