



Wimbledon Park Lake Project - (Reservoir Safety and Desilting)

Summary of Technical Steering Group Meeting – 23 January 2018

Project Status

Discussions on Funding & Partnering Opportunities: The group reviewed and discussed possible funding bids. It was agreed that the group need to work on gaining clarity on potential costs for all aspects of the project whilst seeking out what opportunities might be available. A small group will start work to list all possibilities.

Programme of Activities

- Ecological Impact Assessment – This is now out to tender on the London Portal
- Fish Study – This has been commissioned and the study will take place in the next month
- Tree Matters – Self-seeded saplings – the plan for works is still to be agreed with and then implemented. Tree survey on the Wimbledon Club, LBM land and part of the Golf Course land is still to be developed as a joint commission, led by the AELTC on behalf of the group – this would only be of sufficient scope to support the lake improvement works.
- Flood Study – The Flood Study brief is now live on the Merton portal for tendering. The brief is wider than the scope on the Section 10 Supervising Engineer Report and will also look at cost versus benefits. Closing date for tenders is February 5th 2018.
- Sluice Gate Matters – Following a site meeting at the sluice gate it has been agreed that the area around the sluice gate needs clearing of self-seeded saplings, a fallen tree and leaf fall etc. Also at an appropriate time in the future a CCTV survey will need to be carried out of the outflow pipes.
