- A) Notes the result of the informal consultation carried out between 19 June and 17 July 2017 on the proposed extension of the existing CPZ operational hours and a general zone review.
- B. Agrees not to proceed with any amendment to the existing CPZ operational ours.

7. Reason for decision

The decision is based on the overall feedback received from the zone. Additionally, the low level of support from Worcester Rd, Compton Rd and Alwyne Rd does not warrant a major change such as a change in hours or splitting the zone

8. Alternative options considered and why rejected

The option of splitting W2 zone into two separate zones with different hours and days of operation i.e. one zone to include Brockham Close, Lake Rd, Lake Close, Leeward Gdns, Pine Grove, St Mary's Rd, Woodside, Wimbledon Hill Road to remain unchanged and a second zone to include Worcester Rd, Compton Rd, Alwyne Rd and Alexandra Rd with the hours of operation Mon-Sat 8.30am-11pm with or without Sundays 2-6pm, has been considered. However, due to poor response rate from W2 zone including all those roads affected and in the absence of reasonable level of support a decision has been made to retain status quo. The decision is also based on the possible adverse impact the division would have on those roads that would be retaining existing hours of operation.
