## Dear Resident

Following the recent consultation in December 2013, the Council would like to inform you of its decision to proceed with the statutory consultation and to seek your views for certain alterations to parking restrictions as shown on the plan overleaf.

These changes will compliment the introduction of the approved measures to include, a entry treatments in Rutlish Road and Kirkley Road at the their junctions with Kingston Road whereby the road is raised with ramps to the same level as the footway similar to Pincott Road in Merton High Street; banding features approximately 2 metres wide constructed from cobbled granite installed across the carriageway approaching each of the junctions along Charles Road and Shelton Road; and new free standing planters.

## WHAT HAPPENS NEXT

A statutory consultation is required to alter the parking places and yellow line restrictions. A Notice of the Council's intentions to introduce these alterations will be published in the local newspaper and posted on lamp columns in the vicinity. Objections must relate only to the above aspects of the scheme that are subject to this statutory consultation.

Any representation must be put in writing to the Head of Street Scene and Waste, Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden, Surrey, SM4 5DX by no later than 7 February 2014, quoting reference ES/SGE/homezonelite swimbledon.

A copy of the Notices and plan identifying the area affected by the proposal can be inspected at Merton Link, Merton Civic Centre, London Road, Morden, Surrey during the Council's working hours, Monday to Friday, between 9am and 5pm.

All objections along with Officers' comments and recommendations will be presented to the Cabinet Member for Environmental Sustainability and Regeneration. Please note that responses to any representations received will not be made until a final decision is made by the Cabinet Member. The Council is required to give weight to the nature and content of your representations and not necessarily the quantity. Your reasons are, therefore, important to us. Once a decision is made you will be informed accordingly.
