Proposed Safety Measures Wimbledon Park Primary School Havana Road (between Durnsford Road and Lucien Road)

Dear Resident/Business

The Council in partnership with Wimbledon Park Primary School and your local Ward Councillors are proposing some safety measures along this section of road within the vicinity of the school.

It is envisaged that the measures will further improve traffic flows, lower vehicle speeds, safer crossing points and contribute to a "School Safety Zone" ambience in the neighborhood and create a pleasant environment.

The Proposals include

1. To introduce a 20mph speed limit. Associative signs with an additional vertical measure (speed table) and the removal of the existing round top hump outside property number 37. This will raise driver awareness to further reduce vehicle speeds in the 'zone' specifically on approach to the school entrance where children and parents congregate.
2. The implementation of a junction entry table with Lucien and Wellington Road. This will provide a safer area for pedestrians to cross and enable vehicles to drive at lower speeds with improved visibility of the junction 'ahead' where all road users especially 'school children' are waiting to cross.
3. The introduction of some road markings such as 'slow', '20mph' and school child legends.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT

The Council carries out careful consultation to ensure all road users are given a fair opportunity to give their views and express their needs on parking proposals and road safety issues.

Proposed measures 1 and 2 are subject to a statutory consultation.

A Notice of the Council's intention to introduce the above measures will be published in a local newspaper (The Guardian), London Gazette and posted on lamp columns in the vicinity. Representations for and against the proposals described in this Notice must be made in writing to trafficandhighways@merton.gov.uk by no later than **13th January 2017 quoting reference Havana Road School Safety**.
