Dear Resident / Business

Following the Council's decision to introduce the CW3 CPZ in the Pitcarn Road area, I am writing to inform you that the works will start 20 March 2017, which will be carried out by F M Conway Ltd on behalf of the Council.

DATE AND TIME OF WORKS

It is anticipated that the works will start the week commencing 20 March 2017 for a period of 2 weeks, weather permitting. Work will be carried out between 8am and 4.30pm. To allow the works to be carried out as quickly as possible, temporary parking restrictions will be introduced. "No Parking" cones and signs will be in place to indicate the areas where parking would be prohibited. By doing so, this will keep the roads free of parked vehicles allowing a smooth transition of the works. Vehicles would be allowed back into the road to park once the lining work is complete or after the working day. Offending vehicles run the risk of receiving a fine and possible relocation. Residents will be allowed to park on the completed bays during the implementation work.

Notices and cones will be placed in your road 12 – 48hrs prior to work being undertaken.

SCHEDULE OF WORKS: The work schedule of when your road will be marked is shown below.

- Finborough Road, Flander Crescent, Shrewton Road, Arnold Road, Woodley Close and Swains Road 20/21 March.
- Pitcarn Road, Fleming Mead, North Place 22/23 March.
- Crusoe Road and Friday Road 24 March.
- Myrna Close, Alexandra Road, Taylor Road, Tudor Place, and Waldo Place **27/28 March**.
- Victoria Road, Kenmare Drive Devodale 29/30 March and Singleton Close 31 March.

The information pack on how to apply for your permit will follow shortly. The Council is conscious of the inconvenience and the disruption that this work may cause and will endeavour to keep the impact to a minimum. We apologise in advance for any inconvenience that may be caused by these works.

Proposed Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) CW3 - Pitcairn Road area.

Dear Resident / Business

This leaflet is to update the community of the outcome of the statutory consultation that was carried out in October / November 2016, and to inform you of the Council's decision to introduce the proposed CW3 CPZ to include Alexandra Road, Arnold Road, Crusoe Road, Dovedale Rise, Finborough Road, Flanders Crescent, Fleming Mead, Friday Road, Island Road, Kenmare Drive, London Road (between Victoria Road and Finborough Road), Myrna Close, North Place, Pitcairn Road, Shrewton Road, Singleton Close, Swains Road, Tudor Place, Victoria Road, Waldo Place and Woodley Close as shown in the plan overleaf.

The statutory consultation resulted in 24 representations, 1in favour, 4 comments and 19 against. Majority of the objectors are from Island Road which also voted against the proposed CPZ during the informal consultation. All representations received during the statutory consultation along with officer's recommendations were reported to the Cabinet Member for Regeneration, Environment and Housing in February 2017. After careful consideration the following have been agreed:

- To proceed with the making of the relevant Traffic Management Orders (TMO) and the implementation of the proposed CW3 CPZ operational Monday – Friday between 8.30am and 6.30pm. due to lack of majority support Island Road will not be included within the CPZ. however to ensure safety and access, double yellow lines will be introduced at its junctions.
- To implement an exemption Order to allow partial footway parking (two wheels on the footway) in Fleming Mead and Friday Road.
- Singleton Close will be included within the existing CW CPZ operating Monday – Friday between 8.30am and 6.30pm.

What happens next

The final made TMO, which allows the restrictions to be implemented and administered, will be published in the London Gazette and the local newspaper shortly. Notices will



also be placed on lamp columns in the affected areas. It is anticipated that the CPZ will come into operation on 18 April 2017. The report and the decision sheet can be viewed on the Council's website, www.merton.gov.uk/cpzcw3
