The purpose of this leaflet is to let you know the outcome of the statutory consultation carried out in August 2009, and to inform you of the Council's decision on the proposed 'H2' Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ), which includes Caxton Road, Cowper Road, Dryden Road, Milton Road, Tennyson Road and property nos. 1 to 108 Garfield Road. The representations received along with officers' recommendations were presented in a report to the Cabinet Member for Planning and Traffic Management who has agreed to proceed with the implementation of the controls as advertised and as shown on the plan overleaf (Drg No. Z78-154-01D).

## WHAT HAPPENS NEXT

The final made Traffic Management Orders (TMOs), which allows the restrictions to be implemented and administered, will be published in the London Gazette and the local newspaper shortly. Notices will also be placed on lamp columns in the affected area.

### **Planned Work - H2 CPZ**

Following the recent consultation on proposals to introduce 'H2' Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ), which includes Caxton Road, Cowper Road, Dryden Road, Milton Road, Tennyson Road and property nos. 1 to 108 Garfield Road, a decision has now been made to implement the scheme. I am therefore writing to inform you that the works will start shortly, which will be carried out by F M Conway Ltd on behalf of the Council.

### **Date and Time of Works**

It is anticipated that works will start the week commencing 23rd November 2009 for a period of 4 weeks (but the lining work should take 7 - 10 working days to complete), weather permitting. Work will be carried out between 9am and 4.30pm. While work is being undertaken in your street, we request that you park in the surrounding roads in '3E' and '3F' CPZs on the west side of Haydon's Road and display the yellow card provided on the dashboard of your vehicle. By doing so, this will keep the roads free of parked vehicles allowing a smooth transition of the work. To facilitate these works, temporary restrictions on parking indicated by signs and cones will be in place. Offending vehicles run the risk of receiving a fine and possible relocation, should they park during the restricted times. Notification will be given 12 - 48hrs prior to work being undertaken in your road.

The information pack on how to apply for your permit will follow shortly. The Council is conscious of the inconvenience and the disruption that this work would cause and will endeavour to keep the impact to a minimum while the works are being carried out. We apologise in advance for any inconvenience that may be caused by these works.
